## **Glorify God in your Body**

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

Main Idea: Recognizing who we are in Christ, we flee sexual immorality and seek to glorify God in our bodies.

### Recognizing who we are in Christ, we must use our bodies for the Lord.

- 12 "All things are lawful for me," but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful for me," but I will not be dominated by anything. 13 "Food is meant for the stomach and the stomach for food"—and God will destroy both one and the other.
- The body is not meant for sexual immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body. 14 And God raised the Lord and will also raise us up by his power.
  - o 1 Corinthians 15:40-42

Am I using my body for the Lord or myself?

# Recognizing who we are in Christ, we must treat our bodies as members of Christ.

- 15 Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? Never! 16 Or do you not know that he who is joined to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For, as it is written, "The two will become one flesh."
  - o 1 Corinthians 12:27
  - Ephesians 5:30-32
- 17 But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him.
  - Ephesians 4:4-6

Am I treating my body as a member of Christ?

### Recognizing who we are in Christ, we must flee sexual immorality.

- 18 Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body.
  - Ephesians 5:3

Am I fleeing sexual immorality?

#### Recognizing who we are in Christ, we must seek to glorify God in our bodies.

- 19 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, 20 for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.
  - o 1 Corinthians 10:31
